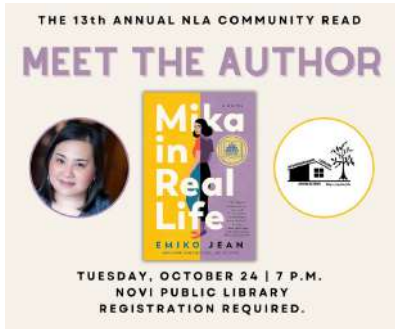

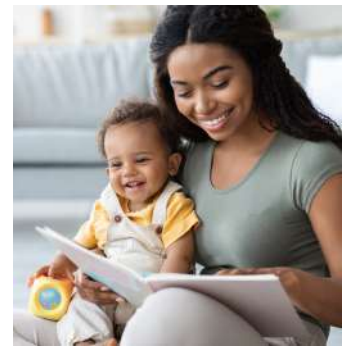


Baby Storytime

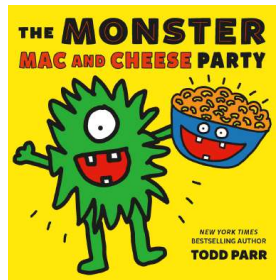

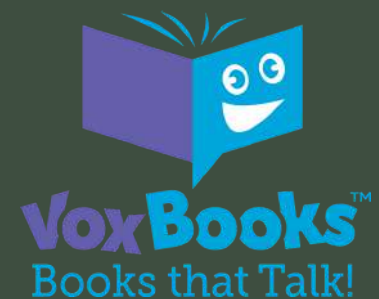

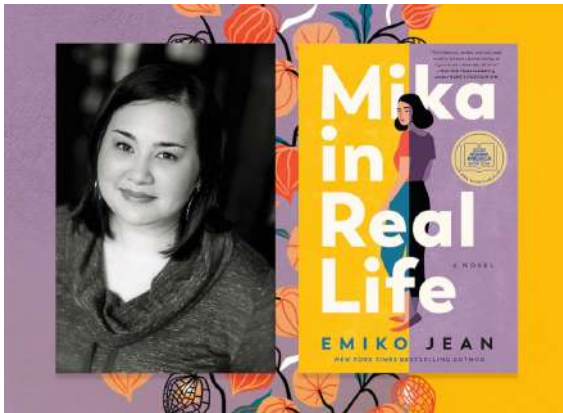
